

Call for Research

2010 KRA Studies and Research Award

Have you investigated some aspect of literacy in your classroom or school? Have you completed a graduate research project addressing a topic in the field of reading? Have you recently published an article in a professional journal? If you can answer YES to any of these questions and your project was completed in the past two years (after January 1, 2008), you are encouraged to submit your research for consideration for the **2010 KRA Studies and Research Award**. Awards are available for both published and unpublished research.

If you are submitting unpublished research, write a summary of your study including the following information:

- the problem or reason for your study
- a description of any commercial materials, teacher-made materials, and/or assessments used in the study
- the method you used to conduct the research
- results of the study
- the implications of your findings for teachers

Your submission should be a maximum of 15 pages including any references, charts, and tables. Submit your research by email attachment for review by the selection committee.

If you are submitting a published article, submit the article itself for review. Be sure to include complete bibliographic information for the journal in which it appeared.

The Studies and Research Award will be presented at the 2010 KRA Conference in Junction City, KS in October 2010. Each recipient of the KRA Research Award will receive a framed certificate and \$100. Award recipients are expected to attend the conference to receive their recognition in person.
